



To execute the Written Verdict

For many years now, faithful believers have been proclaiming God's word from the walls of Jerusalem.

Isaiah 62 foretells that watchmen will give themselves and God "no rest" and constantly "remind" Him of his promises and prophecies. Believers proclaim God's word aloud and with authority, not on their own authority but in the authority of their Lord Yeshua.

In Psalm 149 we read that worship is an essential element of these proclamations. It's not limited to praising the Lord, in verse 6 we read "May the praise of God be in their mouths and a *double-edged sword in their hands*". Watchmen are engaged in spiritual warfare! God's word is that double-edged sword (Revelation 19:11-16).

Worship and spiritual warfare work in tandem.

In order to help budding watchmen on their way, you'll find here a number of powerful scriptures. This is by no means a complete list but they will assist you on the road to fulfilling your watchman's calling.

Suggestions when proclaiming the Psalms:

First and foremost, the Psalms were written for Israel. Where it says "me, us, we", you can replace that with Israel. That will make the scripture personal and focussed.
